Saitama University Students Behavioral Guidelines

We are working to prevent the spread of new coronavirus infections based on the "Manual for dealing with new coronavirus infections".

To protect each other, students should follow the manual and take the following actions.

Open Windows



To ventilate the air in classrooms, open multiple windows for a few minutes more than once per hour.

Keep distance



Maintain a distance, 1 meter or more with other people.

Avoid crowds



Avoid close conversations and vocalizations.

If it is unavoidable, wear a mask.

Keep doors open



Keep doors open to avoid touching shared surfaces.

Wash and Clean



Please wash your hands frequently before and after lectures or research. Also, be sure to carry a towel or handkerchief with you.

Check temperature



Check your temperature every Morning. If you have a fever, do not come to the university and follow the manual.

Keep a log



Keep a record of where you sat and who you were with during classes, studies, and meals in case contact tracing is necessary.

Stay home



Stay at home and avoid going to the university or going out for non-essential purposes.
