COURSES

CuriousU offers a total of eight separate courses from 11-18 August 2015.

MIX & MATCH

You can earn two European Credits if you complete a full course, which means participating in sessions from one course for the whole week and attending all lectures, projects, and workshops. In some cases, these credits count towards a University of Twente Master's programme.

If you are not interested in earning extra credits, you can mix and match various sessions from the courses on offer: combine a workshop in design with a lecture in entrepreneurship, for example! Please note that if you opt for Serious Gaming, you will not be able to mix and match as you will need the whole week to complete your game.

1. HEALTH AND HAPPINESS

Inspired by insights from health sciences, positive psychology and eHealth, this course will help you address issues in the field of health and well-being.

Smart Cities make extensive and effective use of big data and IT, and employ smart incentives to encourage small-scale and efficient solutions for energy and transport. This calls for a new style of governance, with the active involvement of a wide diversity of public, private and citizens' organizations.
