# Saitama University International House Housing Information for September 2019

Saitama University is pleased to offer International House (I-House) residence to the applicants based on the following requirements. This application is for those who wish to get a permission to move into I-House, as well as for those who are currently living in I-House but wish to change the ROOM TYPES. (Address: I-House 645 Shimo-okubo, Sakura-ku, Saitama-shi, Saitama 338-0825 JAPAN)

### 1. Eligibility requirements

- Only applicants who meet all the following criteria will be considered:
- ①International students scheduled to enroll at Saitama University as of October 1, 2019.
- ② Someone who does not exceed the standard course duration of the enrolled program as of October1, 2019.
- ③Someone who does not plan to take leave of absence from Saitama University as of October 1,2019.

(4) If the applicant has already been residing in Japan before October 2019, he/she must not exceed the duration of living in I-House for a total of one year. However, someone may apply again only when his/her academic status changes. (Ex: Doctoral course student may apply again even if he/she had lived in I-House for one year during his/her Master's course.)

2. Period of residence

Date of moving-in : September 18 (Wed), 2019 Date of moving-out : March 6 (Fri), 2020 or August 21 (Fri), 2020

## From July 1 (Mon), 2019 to July 31 (Wed), 2019

- 5. Screening
  - ① Priority is given to the applicants who live outside Japan before October 2019.
  - 2 As for the applicants who have already lived in Japan, the priority will be given only if they are in their final academic year of their enrolled programs. Financial situations of the applicants will be considered.
  - ③ Someone whose academic status changed is eligible to apply again even if he/she had lived in Japan and in I-House for a total of one year. However, the priority will be at the lowest.

- 7. Available rooms
- (1) Types of rooms

There are 3 types of rooms; SINGLE ROOM (1 room), COUPLE ROOM (1 large room or 2 rooms) and FAMILY ROOM (3 rooms).

Guarantee Deposit will be charged for the first 5 months. Lump sum payment is not accepted.
The balance of your deposit will be refunded after the final payment.

② Electricity, gas, water and telephone will be charged according to the amount used.

In addition to the above, optional bedding sets rental is available as follows:
¥3,600 per month

Bedding sets include: a pillow, a pillowcase, a mattress pad, two bed sheets, a blanket, and a comforter

④ Rates and fees are subject to change.

### 8. Remarks

- ① Since the number of rooms is limited, not all applicants will be permitted. Applicants may not request to choose buildings or types of rooms.
- ② The size and layouts of the same room types are different in each building. Once the room is assigned, you may not request for any changes.
- Regardless of your actual move-in date, the fee will be charged from the move-in date stated in "2. Period of residence".

Even if you move in from October, half the fee of September will be charged.

- ③ Even if you stay for one day, you will need to pay the full amount of monthly rent.
- ④ We do not keep your luggage prior to your check-in day. Please check-in with your luggage.
