I also loved the museum and seeing all the old toys which you could collect from previous pockey packs. It was also interesting to learn about how Japan used to look like, and how pockey was seen in the older generations of Japanese.</p> <p>After the pockey factory, we went to a traditional town and learned how to make washi. I really enjoyed the Japanese food that we got, and how there were so many parts and flavours of the dish as it wasn't just a single dish. The scenery of that town was also beautiful, and I loved seeing the koi fish and paper lanterns decorated around the time. I also really enjoyed hearing one of the buskers play a style of Jazz that I've never heard before, which felt distinctively Japanese as well. Making paper was also interesting, and I really enjoyed watching the documentary whilst waiting for the other students to finish. I didn't realise it took that much effort to make one piece of traditional Japanese paper! It was really nice to hear that the Japanese government was supporting this tradition so it could be passed onto the future generations of Japanese people.</p> <p>Finally, we went to a beautiful town with an absolutely stunning river. 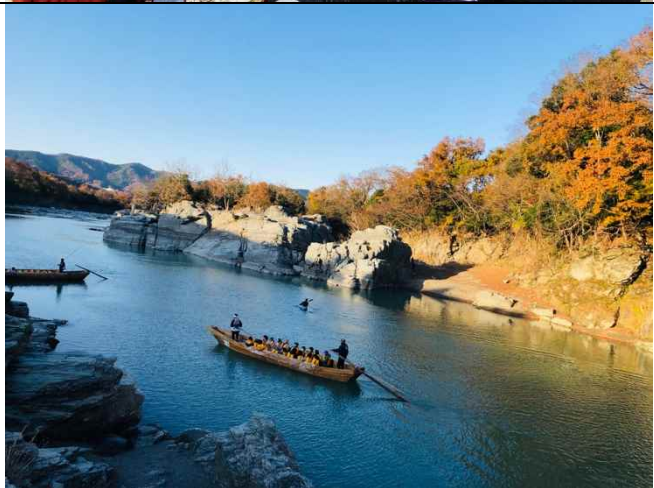

很荣幸，能够参加这次由公益財団法人中島記念国際交流財団助成举办的 bus tour。

从形式上讲：此次的 bus tour 中规中矩，并无任何缺陷或创新，是一种十分适合团队到近距离乡下游玩的形式。

从旅游路线上讲：对外国人而言，bus tour 的路线是一条非常经典的路线，兼顾日本工业、手工业和自然环境，能让我们外国人留学生对日本有个广泛却不粗糙的认识。第一站是日本现代大手企业，体验现代日本的工业并能品尝零食（pocky 真的很好吃）。第二站是日本传统美食和传统手工艺，中午的乌冬面无论从环境还是味道，都十分让人惊喜，而饭后体验造纸工艺也充满了乐趣。第三站长瀨的岩畳，向我们展示了日本的自然风光，此站也是我个人最喜欢的一站。上游荒川的激流直转而下，水势逐渐平稳，江面逐渐宽阔，流过两岸峭壁，从下游的浅滩直奔远方。对岸鲜艳的红叶、灿烂的黄叶和锦带般的瀑布展现着秋的绝美，而眼前的凋零的枯木、干涸的河槽和裸漏的层岩又在提醒我们秋天的肃杀，一条荒川分割两岸，完全不一样的景致形成了新明强烈的对比，可谓是秋之绝景。

从向导工作上讲：我对 A 组的向导和工作人员十分的满意。虽然 bus tour 已经过去将近一个星期，巴士上的场景还历历在目。早上出发时，照顾晕车人员而进行的换座处理；上午车上的互动游戏；中午为了让我们更了解埼玉的小问答；下午回程时照顾到全体人员的疲惫而并无太多活动。这一切的安排都很合适，让人感到十分惬意。在所有活动中，我认为「アルプス一万尺」是最能够活跃气氛的。这种童谣+拍手歌的形式让人在不知不觉中放下防备，身体上少量的接触也迅速拉近了人与人之间的距离却不至于由于过度接近而造成别人的反感。事实上，也是从这个游戏开始，巴士内上上下下开始出现欢乐的氛围。

最后谈几点个人认为可以更加优秀的地方：

- 1.在安排乘客上车时，可以考虑独自前来和组队前来的游客两类，如果游客独自前来，我们可以为他安排邻居。在这次 bus tour 中，出现了一些几个人单独做一个双人座的情况，他们没有人可以互动，在一整天的活动中都有些格格不入。
- 2.在下车游玩的时候，也可以考虑小分队的形式，每个小分队由 1 到 2 名日本学生带领，共 6~8 人，尽量进行集体活动（当然也可以和其他小队一起活动或者请示后的单独活动）。在最后的自由活动时间，一些外向、或者爱拍照的人，在各个照片中普遍出现，但一些内向的人，却很难见到他们的身影。集体大合照虽然人很全，但每个人都相对弱化，6~8 人的小组照片更能体现出每个人各自的风采。

<p>Zur Bus-Trip in Saitama würden wir von der Universität Saitama und der Bezirksverwaltung eingeladen.</p> <p>Nach kurzer Einteilung auf die Busse und ersten Bekanntmachen ging es los zum ersten Ziel: Glico Fabrik. Auf dem Weg dahin spielten wir Spiele im Bus und guckten uns bei der einstündigen Fahrt das industrielle Saitama an. Landschaftlich überraschte uns auf der Autobahn der Berggipfel von Fuji-San.</p> <p>Bei dem Fabrikgelände angekommen, wurde uns zunächst die Geschichte vorgestellt und mir fielen direkt Parallelen zu Europäischen Produkten ein. Als Bilder von auf anderen Märkten vertriebenen Marken gezeigt wurden, kam mir „Mikado “ bekannt vor. Unter diesem Namen wird es in Deutschland verkauft und ist auch der Name eines Spiels mit langen dünnen Stäbchen. Die japanischen Studenten halfen angenehmer Weise bei der Übersetzung der Fabrikführung und auch beim anschließenden Quiz.</p> <p>Auf dem Weg zum nächsten Ziel spielten wir die ein Ratespiel, bei dem eine Person sämtliche Form bzw. Existenz annehmen kann und der Bus riet mit Ja-Nein-Fragen. Ich hatte Glück und durfte als zweiter in den Geschenketrog greifen.</p> <p>Beim Washi-no-Sato angekommen spazierten wir durch den kleinen, aber schönen, Garten. Ich war von einem alten Haus begeistert, weil es wie in meiner norddeutschen Heimat mit Reet gedeckt war. Die Pantoffeln in den Räumlichkeiten des Mittagessen reichten zwar nur exakt für die Hälfte des Fußes, aber das tat dem leckeren und üppigen Essen keinen Abbruch. Dafür kamen meine neu gewonnenen Stäbchen direkt zum Einsatz. Mit gestärktem Magen und neuen Informationen über japanische Nudelarten ging es mit traditionell japanischer Papierherstellung weiter. Nach einer kurzen Einführung in den Hintergrund des Papiers und der Gewinnung der Materialien, krepelten wir unsere Ärmel hoch und nahmen unsere Uhren zum Schutz ab. Ein Washi-Meister führte unsere Hand beim gleichmäßigen Schütteln des Siebes. Jeder Teilnehmer stellte ein Blatt Papier her, ein kleiner Namenszettel sicherte die spätere Zuordnung. In den Haus waren auch ganze Kunstwerke, wie etwa ein Storch oder Gemälde, mit diesem festen Papier ausgestellt.</p> <p>Der letzte Stopp war bei Nagatoro eine stelle an einem großen Fluss mit rauem, felsigem Ufer. Man hätte sogar Raftingtouren in Bussen machen können. 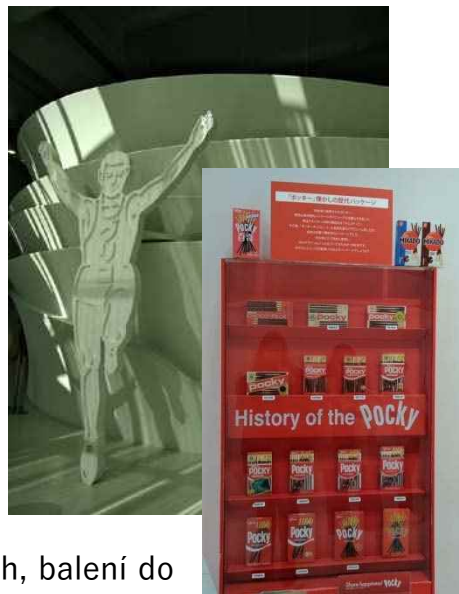

Náš výlet se skládal ze tří hlavních částí. Asi hodinu poté, co jsme vyjeli ze Saitamské university jsme dojeli do GlicoPia East, jedné z poboček firmy Glico která se zabývá výrobou Pocki tyčinek, PRETZ tyčinek a dalších sladkostí. Celá budova, založena v roce 2012, byla příjemně provoněná čokoládou a dozvěděli jsme se tam postup výroby jak Pocki tyčinek máčených v čokoládě, tak i těch slaných. Mohli jsme vidět tovární výrobu tyčinek od jejich tvarování a pečení, přes třízení na pásech, balení do

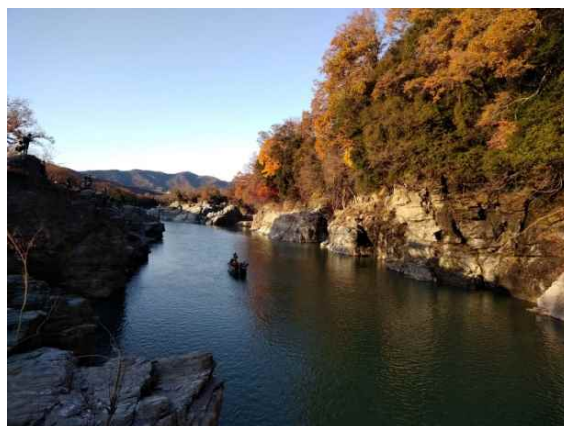


krabiček a obalování kartonů po 10 kusech. Přesto že Glico nemá pobočku v České Republice, má ji v 11 dalších zemích mezi které patří například Thajsko, Amerika, Kanada nebo Francie.

Naší další zastávkou bylo Washi-no-Sato v Higashi Chichibu, kde se ručně vyrábí Washi papír, což je dokonce u jednou z památek UNESCO. K výrobě papíru se používá morušovník. Výrobu papíru jsme si mohli i vyzkoušet. Voda se slizem získaný ze zpracování kmenů morušovníku se v dřevěném rámu převaluje střídavými pohyby ze strany na stranu a ze předu do zadu dokud se nevytvořila vrstva, která se pak přenesla na hromádku již čekajících ‚papírů‘. Papír se později suší.



Po návštěvě výroby papíru jsme naši cestu zakončily v překrásném Nagatoru, přírodním



místě oblíbeném turisty především kvůli možnosti plavby na loďkách na řece Arakawa. Řeka

Především na podzim, kdy se listí barví do všech možných odstínů od zlaté po sytě červenou, je Nagatoro vhodné k navštívení.
